

Bi-lingual/Spanish Speaking Outreach Worker/Trainer

The Midstate COSH Outreach Worker will be meeting with immigrant workers throughout our 11-county jurisdiction of the Southern Tier and southern Finger Lakes. Our primary focus is to advocate for a healthy and safe workplace, helping with workplace injuries and illnesses and leading training workshops. Our outreach workers also advocate and help workers with immigration issues, obtaining a driver's license, housing issues and wage and working conditions at their workplace. Our trainers are required to successfully complete training in our core modules of Identifying and Controlling Hazards, OSHA Rights, Chemical Hazards, Infectious Disease Prevention and Control, Know Your (Immigration) Rights. The new trainers will also be trained in our model of popular education and interview techniques. It is a great asset to our work when our Outreach Workers have a cultural acquaintance and competence with Hispanic immigrant workers.

Beginning outreach workers will work with experienced MCOSH organizers/trainers. The work is part time and occasional depending on the status of our grants. However, in the future, this can lead to a full-time position. The current wage rate is \$25/hour with progressions to the Tompkins County Living Wage (\$25.60 7/1/25; \$26.20 10/1/25; \$26.82 1/1/26) with a mileage rate for use of personal automobiles.
